Vehicle Parking Policy for Students.

- Our school parking policy is designed to safeguard the health and safety of all persons on the school grounds. Safe driving habits and speed limits must always be observed.
- Students are strongly discouraged from taking cars to school, however, if it is absolutely essential for a student to drive to school they must register their vehicle with the school by contacting either the Deputy Principal or Principal.
- Speeding, reckless operation, making excessive noise etc. on school grounds or near any school building will not be tolerated.
- Students must park in the designated area only.
- Cars must be locked in the morning and must not be entered or moved during the day without official permission.
- Students are not permitted to carry passengers other than siblings. Any student who uses a vehicle to transport other students will lose the privilege of parking on school grounds, unless written authorisation has been submitted to the Deputy Principal or Principal from the Parent/Guardian of the student(s) in question.
- Parking on school grounds is a privilege that may be revoked on the basis of school truancy, arriving late, attendance problems or violation of these rules or of other school rules and regulations.
- Cars are parked at the owners own risk.
